

## Foam Plugs Foam plugs, made from expandable slow-recovery

DESCRIPTION

foam, provide the best combination of comfort and protection for most users. They must be properly prepared for insertion. One size fits most. Once in the ear, foam plugs expand to provide a snug and secure custom fit. The two most common complaints about foam plugs ("not enough protection," and "they don't stay in") are almost always solved by greater practice and care in insertion.

PROTECTOR TYPE



Premolded plugs are made from flexible materials that are preformed to fit the ear. They are generally available with a joining cord to prevent loss. Although the version pictured at the left is a one-sized product, many premolded plugs are sold in two or more sizes and must be individually sized for each ear. If after a period of regular wear you've been unable to get used to your earplugs, try another size, type, or brand



Reach around the back of your head and pull outward and upward on the ear while inserting the plug until you feel it sealing. This may seem tight at first, especially if

you've never worn earplugs.
