

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS _____

DEFINITIONS

- Do not use this product if it is visibly worn, distorted or damaged.


SPECIFICATIONS _____

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Unpack and remove the unit from the shipping carton / pallet.
- 2. Inspect the unit for any visible damage.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Press the raised foot pedal down to open cradle arms.
- 2. Move cart forward so that tire stack is centered on frame and between cradle arms.
- 3. Slowly release foot pedal to close arms.
- 4. Tilt top of cart towards you while steadying tire stack.
- 5. Move tire stack to new location and slowly straighten cart to upright position.
- 6. To release tire stack, depress raised foot pedal and move cart back.
- 7. Once clear of tire stack, slowly release pedal.
