

# **Quick Start Guide P4500i**

TOOLS YOU WILL NEED







Screw Driver (not included)



4-stroke engine oil (included)

### **BEFORE STARTING**

#### 1. Add Engine Oil

- a. Unclip and remove the oil service panel to access the oil/fill drain plug.
- b. Remove oil fill plug/dipstick.
- Using the supplied 4-cycle engine oil and funnel, slowly add engine oil to the engine until full.
- d. Do not overfill, if oil level is too high, oil will drain out through the fill plug.





#### 2. Add Unleaded Gasoline to Gas Tank


- a. Unscrew gas cap on top of tank and insert a clean funnel into the tank.
- b. Slowly add gasoline into the fuel tank. The gasoline level should NOT be higher than the filler neck.
- c. Secure gas cap.




- a. Make sure you are outside and 15ft (4.5m) away from any doors or windows.
- b. Only operate on flat, dry surfaces. Do not move the generator while it is running. Do not refill gas while generator is running.


## MANUAL STARTING


- 1. Make sure nothing is plugged into power outlets.
- Remove battery access cover and connect battery leads.
- Make sure the circuit breakers are properly set to operating.
- Turn the Fuel Control Switch to the ON position.
- 5. Switch Engine Control Switch to RUN.
- 6. Firmly grasp and pull the recoil handle slowly until you feel increased resistance. At this point, apply a rapid pull while pulling out from the inverter.
- 7. Plug in electronic devices.








# **ELECTRIC STARTING**


- Make sure nothing is plugged into power outlets.
- Remove battery access cover and connect battery leads.
- Make sure the circuit breakers are properly set to operating.
- Turn the Fuel Control Switch to the ON position.
- 5. Switch Engine Control Switch to RUN.
- 6. Push and hold the engine start button for 1 second and release.
- 7. For remote start hold the **START** button on the wireless remote for 1 second and release.
- 8. Plug in electronic devices.


# **MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE**

Following the maintenance schedule is important to keep the inverter in good operating condition. The following is a summary of maintenance items by periodic maintenance intervals. Refer to the *Maintenance* section in the *Owners Manual* to find out how to properly perform maintenance.

#### **TABLE 1: MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE - OWNER PERFORMED**

#### ENGINE OIL | ACEITE DEL MOTOR

Only use 4-stroke/cycle engine oil. **NEVER USE 2-STROKE/CYCLE OIL**. Synthetic oil is an acceptable substitute for conventional oil.
