INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

To release blade from its closed or open position simply press down the blade release lever.




Before sawing make sure to extend the blade completely to its full upright locked position.

To use your saw as an extension saw, push saw release button back.

Slide folding saw up into the in-line channel groove.



To extend the saw out, flip open the compression latch levers. Fully extend the I-Beam out to its stopping point.



 DO NOT push latches down anywhere on the I-Beam other than into the slots.

• When removing saw from the side of the I-Beam lift up. DO NOT pull out.

• Before and after use of the saw it is recommended that you tighten the blade screw to ensure the proper tension of the blade. As typical of all folding saws with use the blade screw can loosen.



Hooyman Saws are made to cut as you pull the blade toward you. By cutting on the pull stroke it requires significantly less energy and gives you more control over the action of the saw. Hooyman Saws are built with unique patent pending technology. Hooyman's signature MegaBite [™] blade is made from a special premium high carbon steel, and a four edge tooth design which results in superior cutting ability. When used properly your Hooyman Saw will give you excellent results. No saw can stand up to misuse and abuse. Inside are instructions for the proper use of your Hooyman Saw. No product replacement will be considered if broken from obvious improper use.

PROPER TECHNIQUE

To get the most effective results from your Hooyman[®] Saw use the strength of the MegaBite[™] teeth. NOT YOUR STRENGTH! Heavy pressure is not necessary and may result in the teeth jamming in the wood fiber. Simply apply controlled power to the pull stroke then easily slide the blade forward. Let the saw do the work.

When cutting larger branches always undercut first. Undercut about halfway. Then place the saw on top of the branch slightly to the right of the first cut and saw downward until the limb breaks away.

If your saw ever does get caught squeezed in a branch, always take the weight off the blade when freeing the saw blade from the branch. NEVER jerk, twist, or push the saw from side to side hoping to release the blade. This may result in your blade breaking!!!
