Caster Sets

Caster Brakes are not suitable for keeping units in place when transporting. Secure by another method. Do not use casters on rough or uneven surfaces. Do not tow caster mounted boxes.

Install padlocks in all KNAACK® Boxes and lock the covers before laying them on their backs or tops for caster installation. This will keep the covers from opening and causing possible serious personal injury or property damage as the boxes are laid on their backs. Failure to heed may result in moderate injury.

BOLT KITS

Two bolt kits have been included with your caster set, depending which type of skid you are mounting to.

BOLT KIT #32-0500 (For Use with Method 1)

5/16"-18 x 3/4" Thread Cutting Bolt

TOOLS REQUIRED

- 3/8" Drive Ratchet
- 3/8" Extension (6" minimum length)
- 1/2" Socket (for Method 1 mounting)
- 9/16" Socket (for Method 2 mounting)

BOLT KIT #32-0213 (For Use with Method 2)



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Method 1 Enclosed Skid Mounting

Note: Load Ratings are based on caster capacities and do not necessarily reflect load carrying capabilities of individual KNAACK® Products.

- 1. When installing on smaller products, lay shipping carton on the floor, and with a minimum of two people, lay the unit on it's back to avoid scratching product. On larger products, lift unit with forklift high enough to work at a comfortable height.
- 2. Decide which end you will steer from. The end you select will have the swivel casters.
- 3. For Method 1, use bolt kit # 32-0500, thread cutting bolts using the 1/2" socket. Torque bolts to 20 ft. lbs. MAXIMUM.
- 4. For **Method 2**, use bolt kit #32-0213 Carriage bolts, nuts and Washers. Tighten fasteners using the 9/16" socket, with orientation as shown in Method 2 figure above.
