

## T-Handle Bit Driver with No. 1, 2, 3 JIS Cross-Head Bits

Have you ever noticed that tiny little dot on a Phillips head screw on a Japanese motorcycle? Have you ever noticed that for some reason, it's always harder to remove these screws with a Philips head screwdriver? That's because they are not a Philips head! That small dot indicates that it is a JIS cross head screw, which is slightly different from the more common Philips head, but they are widely used on Japanese motorcycles. A Philips head screwdriver is shaped wrong and will cam out of a JIS cross head screw, which is why you see all those damaged screw heads on older Japanese motorcycles. Once more, Motion Pro comes to the rescue. The new Motion Pro T-Handle Bit Driver comes with three JIS cross head bits, ready to remove those stubborn screws with a better fit, more bite, and less damage to the screw head. There are magnets in each end of the T-Handle, so all three bits can be stored with the tool, and you can easily move them to the proper position depending on the job at hand.
