IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS AND SAFETY RULES

1. Know your work light. Read this manual carefully. Learn the work light's applications and limitations, as well as, potential hazards specific to it.

3. Do not use the work light if the switch does not turn it on and off. Any tool that cannot be controlled with the switch is dangerous and must be repaired.

5. Although eye damage from the OEMTOOLS Work Light is unlikely, never stare directly into the beam.
6. Do not attempt to recharge the battery by any other means than USB, via the cable provided.
7. When servicing a tool, use only identical replacement parts. Use of unauthorized parts or failure to follow maintenance instructions may create a risk of injury.

CHARGING

Fully charge the battery before first use.

OPERATION

The OEMTOOLS Rechargeable Work Light features a super bright 3W COB for use as an inspection lamp and 7 ultra-bright LEDs in the top for use as a directional light. A push On/Off button is located on the front of the light. A magnetic 180 degree swivel base and 2 super strong magnets on the back allow the user to mount to a metal surface. 2- 360 degree swivel hooks are provided to hang the light from a hood or other object. The Li-Ion long life battery is rechargeable via the included USB lead.

MAINTENANCE

1. Always store the OEMTOOLS Work Light in a well-protected area where it will not be exposed to inclement weather, corrosive vapors, abrasive dust or any other harmful elements.
2. Keep the Work Light clean by wiping with a damp cloth.
3. Inspect cable periodically, and if damaged, replace.
4. Recharge periodically when not in use.

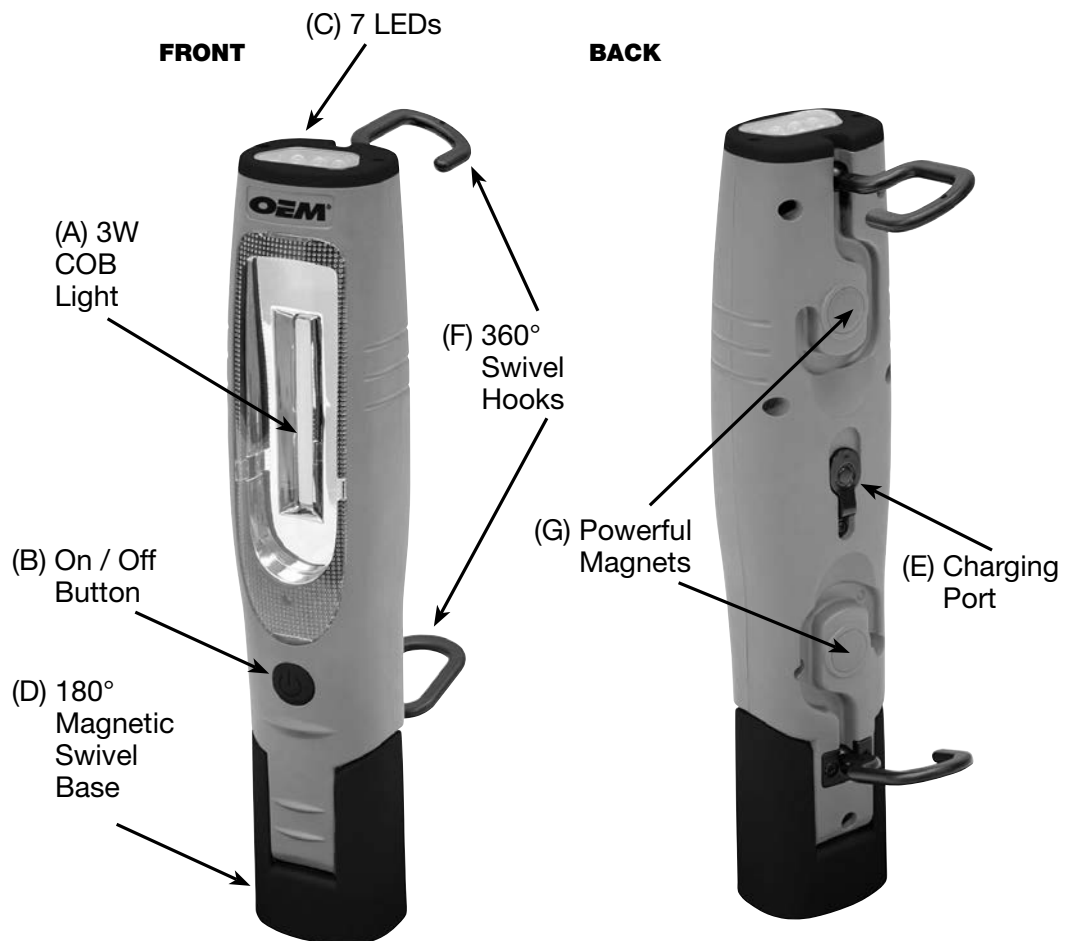
