Heavy-duty Truck Wheel Step

Max. Capacity: 300 lbs.

The heavy-duty truck wheel step is designed to help the technician easily reach engine parts.

Safety Precautions



Caution: To prevent equipment failure or damage resulting in personal injury:



- Read, understand, and follow these instructions.
- If the operator cannot read English, operating instructions and safety precautions must be read and discussed in the operator's native language.



- Wear eye protection that meets the requirements of ANSI Z87.1 and OSHA.
- Inspect the condition of the wheel step before each use; do not use a wheel step if it's damaged, altered, or in poor condition.
- Do not exceed the rated capacity of the wheel step.



- The vehicle must be located on a hard, level surface to use the wheel step. The vehicle must be stable.
- Chock the wheels of the vehicle and set the parking brake before using the wheel step.

Placement Instructions

Wheel Step Placement

- Remove pins and adjust wheel step to best fit the width and the height of the tire; then replace pins.
- 2. Carefully place wheel step over the tire.
- 3. Before standing on the step, test it by placing one foot onto the grid to verify the wheel step is secure.
